The Cyclops Fragment Entity is believed to originate from a larger multi-form apparition commonly associated with Kenner-era Ghostbusters records, specifically the H2 Ghost classification. Unlike a complete manifestation, this entity represents only the lower cyclopean section of the original form, operating independently as a partial ghost.

Origin of the Fragment

In certain paranormal conditions, ghosts do not always manifest as complete entities. Instead, they can appear in fragmented or unstable forms, with different aspects of their identity separating into independent apparitions.

The Cyclops Fragment is thought to be one such case. Originally part of a larger, more complex ghost, the lower body and central eye component manifested independently, forming a self-contained roaming entity.

Physical Appearance

The entity is dominated by a single large central eye, positioned within a compact, rounded body. Its structure appears incomplete, lacking any upper torso or additional appendages normally associated with full humanoid ghosts.

Observed characteristics include:

- Single large cyclopean eye with constant movement
- Compact lower-body mass with undefined upper structure
- Smooth, semi-organic ectoplasmic surface
- Unstable edges suggesting incomplete manifestation

The absence of a full body gives the entity a distorted, almost unfinished appearance, as if only part of the original ghost has crossed into the physical world.

Behaviour and Movement

The Cyclops Fragment exhibits erratic but non-strategic movement. Without a complete form or higher cognitive structure, it appears to operate on instinct rather than intent.

Typical behaviour includes:

- Rapid, unpredictable movement patterns
- Scanning environments using its central eye
- Startling nearby individuals through sudden appearance
- Attempting to evade capture rather than attack

The entity does not display coordinated aggression, but its unpredictable nature makes it disruptive in confined or populated environments.

Psychokinetic Interpretation

Researchers believe the Cyclops Fragment represents a partial emotional or psychological imprint. The central eye may symbolise heightened awareness, surveillance, or fixation, while the missing upper structure suggests incomplete identity or separation from a larger whole.

This type of manifestation is often associated with unstable paranormal conditions, where energy is insufficient to sustain a complete form.

Relationship to Full H2 Entity

The Cyclops Fragment is believed to be directly linked to a larger H2-class ghost form. In rare cases, such fragments may attempt to recombine or may appear alongside other separated components of the same entity.

However, no confirmed full recombination event has been recorded.

Containment Considerations

Despite its incomplete form, the Cyclops Fragment can be captured using standard Ghostbusters equipment. Its lower mass and reduced structural cohesion make it easier to contain than a fully formed Class V entity.

Care must be taken during capture, as its erratic movement can make precise trap placement difficult.

Possible Use in Ghostbusters Research

Fragment entities like this are of particular interest to researchers. They provide insight into how ghosts form, destabilise, and potentially break apart under certain conditions.

Studying the Cyclops Fragment may help improve:

- Understanding of partial manifestations
- Detection of incomplete paranormal forms using PKE Meters
- Trap calibration for low-mass or unstable entities

It also highlights the importance of early detection, as fragmented ghosts may indicate a larger, more powerful entity forming nearby.

Current Status

- Threat level: Low
- Containment status: Captured (fragment class)
- Classification: Partial manifestation entity

The Cyclops Fragment Entity is a reminder that ghosts do not always appear as complete beings. Sometimes, only pieces of something larger emerge, offering a glimpse into a form that may never fully arrive - or one that is still waiting to.
